Edmund de Waal has curated this the first major exhibition of works by the acclaimed Danish ceramists and polymath Axel Salto. He is internationally renowned for his individual and expressive stoneware, which will be seen alongside his illustrations, writings and textiles. We will have a guided tour of the exhibition. We can also visit the wonderful permanent collection of work by Hepworth, Moore, Epstein etc, all displayed in the beautifully lit pigmented concrete building designed by David Chipperfield. Also on show will be Elizabeth Fritsch 'Other Worldly Vessels' and, 'Sculpture with Colour', the Hepworth prize saved for the nation.
